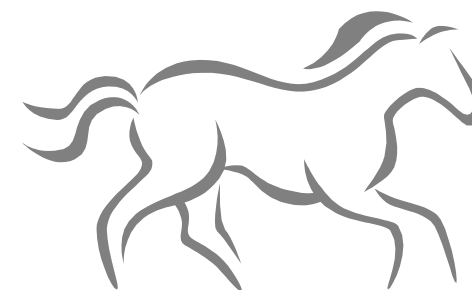

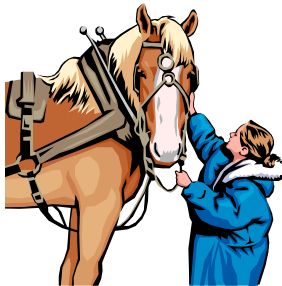

The course is highly recommended for horse owners, trainers, instructors, stable managers, and breeding farms.

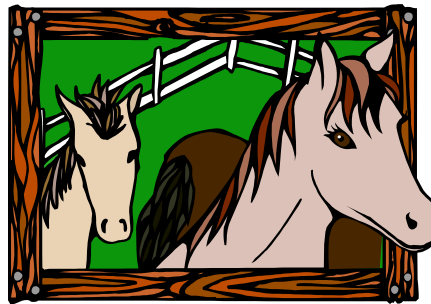
In addition to the basic course curriculum, participants will receive information about available federal and state cost-share programs to assist your horse program.
